Information and Rules for the SMILES Open Benefit Horse Show

- ◇ Age of riders are as of January 1st of the show year
- ◇ Novice: Horse/Rider combination has not won 3 first place ribbons.
- ◇ ** Walk/Trot Classes: Horse-rider combination may not enter Canter Class. No cross entering of age brackets.
- ◇ **FUN CLASS—Hold a “SMILES buck” underneath the riders thigh during walk/trot/lope and other challenges. The last person with the “buck” under their thigh wins!**
 - ◇ *SMILES bucks will be handed out morning of show if you’d like to practice.
- ◇ Original current Coggins papers must be shown & a copy left for SMILES’ files.
- ◇ Health certificate required on all out-of-state horses.
- ◇ 3 minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 min can be requested for a tack change.
- ◇ Separate billing sheet required for each rider/horse combination
- ◇ Show reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
- ◇ No refunds for scratches and no swapping classes. Weekend Hi Point totals combine English and Western Show Days.
- ◇ In case of a tie, the breaker is the horse/exhibitor combo with the highest place in showmanship.
- ◇ Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding— available for \$7 at the show.
- ◇ **Exhibitor is responsible to clean stall after use.**
- ◇ Judge’s decision is final. Show will take place rain or shine.
