Information and Rules for the SMILES Open Benefit Horse Show

- ♦ Age of riders are as of January 1st of the show year
- **Novice:** Horse/Rider combination has not won 3 first place ribbons.
- ** Walk/Trot Classes: Horse-rider combination may not enter Canter Class. No cross entering of age brackets.

FUN CLASS—Hold a "SMILES buck" underneath the riders thigh during walk/trot/lope and other challenges. The last person with the "buck" under their thigh wins! *SMILES bucks will be handed out morning of show if you'd like to practice.

- ♦ Original current Coggins papers must be shown & a copy left for SMILES' files.
- **Health certificate required on all out-of-state horses.**
- **3 minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 min can be requested for a tack change.**
- ♦ Separate billing sheet required for each rider/horse combination
- **Show reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.**
- No refunds for scratches and no swapping classes. Weekend Hi Point totals combine English and Western Show Days.
- **In case of a tie, the breaker is the horse/exhibitor combo with the highest place in showmanship.**
- ♦ Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding—available for \$7 at the show.
- **Exhibitor is responsible to clean stall after use.**
- **Judge's decision is final. Show will take place rain or shine.**
