Age of riders are as of January 1st of the show year.

Novice: Horse/Rider combination has not won 3 first place ribbons ** Walk/Trot Classes: Horse-rider combination may not enter Canter Class Original current Coggins papers must be shown & a copy left for SMILES' files. Health certificate required on all out-of-state horses.

- No Refunds for scratches and no swapping classes.
- JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL
- NO CROSS ENTERING OF AGE BRACKETS
- In case of a tie for High Point, highest place in Showmanship wins.
- Show reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
- MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO "SMILES"
- 3-minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 minutes will be allowed for a requested tack change.
- Office Fee \$10 charged for each rider/horse combination.
- Separate billing sheet required for each rider/horse combination
- Show will take place rain or shine.
- Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding— available for sale at the show.
- Exhibitors clean stalls after use
